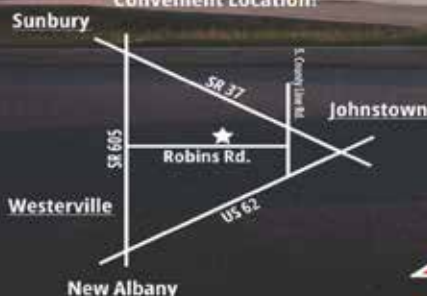

The Ukrainian Cultural Association of Ohio, Inc. (UCAO) was founded in 1983 in Columbus as a 501 (c)(3) nonprofit association devoted to Ukrainian culture. The Association sponsors cultural events, supports philanthropic under-takings, and hosts a variety of social gatherings to promote a better understanding of Ukrainian history and cultural heritage. Since Russian aggression escalated in February 2022 UCAO shifted its focus to helping Ukraine win the war. UCAO cooperates with medical unit (Panfilov) in Ukraine by fundraising and directing funds to send tourniquets.

Twelve-year-old Anatolii Prokhorenko was up in a pear tree in northern Ukraine when he heard the buzz of a drone. His younger siblings and other children were playing nearby. He remembered a lesson from a Ukrainian soldier — and snapped the fiber-optic cable mid-flight. The drone crashed. The children were safe.

Ukrainians call this Russia's "human safari" — the X box-inflected hunting of civilians by drones rigged with explosives, steered by operators miles away. It has reached villages. It has reached children.

The soldiers standing between Russia and the next Anatolii need blood-clotting bandages, chest seals, and tourniquets. UCAO is sending the next shipment soon.

Porsche Salzburg Connection by Andy Trux

Most Porsche Club members know that Porsches are built (primarily) in Stuttgart and the Porsche Factory Museum is in Stuttgart.

Some members also know that Porsches had their origins in an old sawmill in Gmünd Austria. Europe's first private Porsche Museum is situated in Gmünd, the birthplace of the first car named Porsche (1944-1950). The extensive collection contains 40 exhibits: from Porsche 356 style 356 020 ALU, engineered and constructed in Gmünd, from Porsche rally and race cars to special exhibitions changing annually.

The Porsche family's roots in Salzburg, Austria, run deep, tracing back to the aftermath of World War II when Ferry Porsche and his sister Louise Piëch relocated the headquarters of their automotive firm there from Carinthia in 1949.

While Ferry returned to Stuttgart to establish the famous sports car production, Louise and her husband, Anton Piëch, remained in Salzburg. They laid the foundation for the massive Porsche

Holding Salzburg (the largest automotive distributor in Europe) by building the first sales and Volkswagen import organizations in Austria.

Unknown to most Porsche fans, in a small village, about 14 miles from Salzburg, named Mattsee. The fahr(T)raum museum in Mattsee pays tribute to Ferdinand Porsche, the pioneer of the Austrian automotive industry, and the remarkable people who helped shape automotive history. More than a museum, it is an interactive journey through innovation, engineering, and design, where historic vehicles and immersive exhibits connect the past with the future. A fascinating destination for visitors of all ages, fahr(T)raum brings the stories, technology, and spirit of Porsche to life in a truly engaging way.

Among many gems is a collection of Porsche tractors, even a Renault/Porsche tractor. This museum is well worth a visit, as is seeing this beautiful village on the Lake Mattsee.

MORPCA Business Meeting Minutes - May 2026

Attendees: Steve Eisenbrown, Mike Stoner, Debra Stoner, Jose Isern, Kevin Hennessy, Jim Lesser, Frank Todaro, Dave Stetson, Jennifer Reynolds

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

President's Report by Steve Eisenbrown, President: No report.

Treasurer's Report by Jim Lesser, Treasurer: Mike and Jim Lesser have been working together as Jim steps into the role of Treasurer. Jim has developed monthly reports to track expense categories. The group discussed the need for all activity registration monies being entered on-line so no one is collecting and managing cash at club events. Jim will look into using Square software for processing last-minute, in-person registration.

Mike presented the yearly budget. Dave moved to approve the budget and Kevin seconded the motion. No issues were raised and the budget passed.

Mike presented IRS Form 990 for 2025 for non-profit organizations. Kevin made a motion to approve, which Frank seconded. No issues were raised and the motion passed.

Advertising Report by Akash Vaswani, Chairperson: Akash couldn't attend the meeting but sent his report. He is helping to develop email content for advertisers Auto Assets and Rife's Autobody. Rife's will be offering MORPCA members \$100 off any repair. Akash is sending reminder emails and invoices to advertisers who haven't yet paid, and connecting with the COO at Middle West Spirits to revive the advertising relationship.

Membership by Linda Grossglass, Chairperson: Linda couldn't attend the meeting but reported 11 new members, one transferred in, none transferred out, for a total of 1166 members.

Newsletter by Debra Stoner, Editor: Friday, May 15th is the deadline for content. The group discussed photos to be featured in the newsletter of Porsches parked in front of murals depicting the country's upcoming 250th anniversary. Patriotic Porsche pictures may be featured prominently in the newsletter. Approved \$50 gift certificate for the 250 Ohio Mural challenge.

Communication by Kevin Hennessy, Chairperson: Email announcements are going out as scheduled. Kevin reported ongoing issues with MOR's PayPal account. Ticket Tailor now offers in-person credit card processing, which will be used to help reduce registration and payment issues. Kevin and Jim will work together to arrange use of the credit dongle for last-minute, in-person registration.

Social Activities by Frank and Melinda Todaro, Co-Chairpersons: Frank reported that the April Third Thursday Social at The Wyler Collection was a success with 119 attendees. Attendance has increased year over year. Frank noted that fees have increased to offset expenses. Any funds left over after expenses are paid will go to the club's fund for the Annual Holiday Party. The May 21st Third Thursday Social will be held at Horsepower Farms in Powell and the June Social will be held Saturday, June 20th, at Executive Storage Estates in Plain City. Frank will work with Dave to submit details for eligible rebates through PCA.

Concours/P2O by Mat Allison, Chairperson: Mat couldn't attend the meeting but is looking forward to drawing a big crowd of Porsches to the Arthritis Foundation Car Show in July. He will send Debra information to include in the newsletter. Mat is open to additional concours ideas.

Driving Events by Kevin Hennessy and Mike Stoner, Co-Chairpersons: Kevin reported that due to numerous factors increasing the costs of hotel rooms during July 17th - 19th, MORPCA and NNJR decided to cancel the proposed HPDE. The clubs requested that MOSCC roll the \$5000 deposit to a date in 2027 and await a response.

HPDE - Frank reported the June HPDE is approaching break even. Frank is reaching out to potential sponsors. He is planning a Social at the track; deadline for ordering food is June 11th.

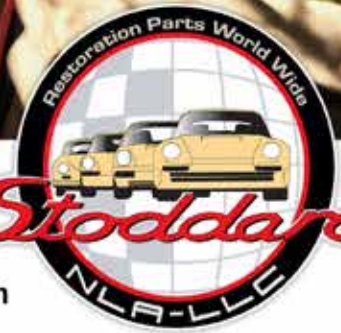

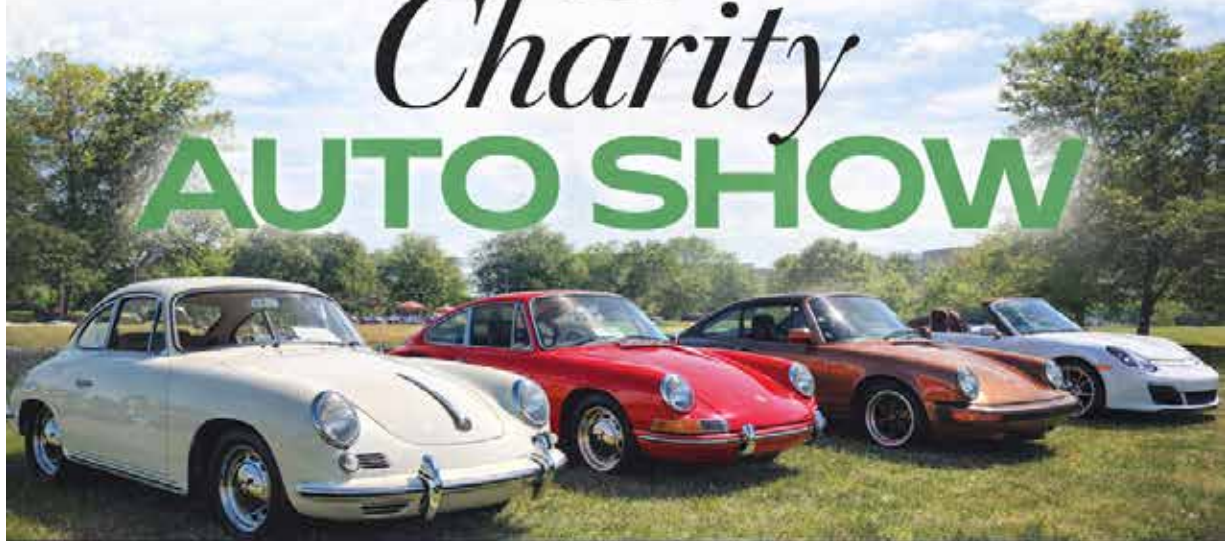
